MACDILL Air Force Base

The impact of operations at MacDill Air Force Base in Fiscal Year 2014 was \$2,944,837,438 leading to an estimated 24,486 indirect jobs created in the local economy.

In addition to the 18, 853 employees on or near MacDill, there is also a large community of over 73,000 retirees and spouses of military retirees residing within 50 miles of the base. Active, Reserve, Guard, federal civil servants, civilian contractors, and retirees continue to contribute to the Tampa Bay region. The rapport between the base and surrounding communities remains excellent and continues to grow.
