



Directions for Disposal

Thank you for using the 6th Medical Group's medication disposal system to safely dispose of your unwanted medications. Proper disposal of prescriptions and over-the-counter medications reduces the potential for harm to your health, households, and environment.

DO'S:

1. Medication must be in their original containers when placed into the collection box.
2. Remove or mark out your personal identifying information from the container.
3. Liquids must be wrapped in a paper towel or other absorbent material and place in a sealed plastic bag (e.g. a zip-lock-bag) before being placed inside the collection box.
4. For questions regarding these disposal requirements speak to a pharmacy representative.

DON'TS:

1. **DO NOT** place any syringes, sharps or other medical waste in the collection box.
2. For questions regarding these disposal requirements speak to a pharmacy representative. .

How to Place Medications in the Collection Box

1. Pull handle down on the collection door
2. Place medication to be disposed on the collection door lip.
3. Close the collection door to allow medications to enter the collection box
4. Pull hand down to ensure medications have completely entered the collection box.
