SUBJECT: MacDill Air Force Base Guidance Memorandum 2017-13-01, Model Aircraft (Hobbyist) Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS)

RELEASABILITY: There are no releasability restrictions on this publication.

1. By order of the Commander, MacDill Air Force Base, this Guidance Memorandum immediately implements guidance and procedures for Operators wishing to fly sUAS under the Model Aircraft (Hobbyist) category on MacDill Air Force Base. Compliance with this memorandum is mandatory. To the extent, its directions are inconsistent with other Air Force publications; the information herein prevails, in accordance with AFI 33-360.
2. Henceforth, sUAS flight operations will not originate from, cross, or overfly the installation proper, as defined by perimeter boundaries, fences, signs, and markings. Recreational use of sUAS on MacDill AFB is strictly prohibited for both civilian and government agencies without a letter of agreement between 6 OSS/OSA and the coordinating party. In the interest of safety, requests to operate unmanned aircraft within flight corridors will not be permitted.
3. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, Management of Records, and disposed of in accordance with Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS).
