MacDill AFB Rules for Halloween Trick-or-Treat: Saturday, 31 October 2020, 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM

DO's

- For a consistent flow of foot traffic, when trick-ortreating, go with the houses on the right as if you were driving down that road
- Must observe social distancing of at least 6 feet between families who are trick-or-treating
- Wear face cloth coverings at all times
 - Note: you can decorate your face cloth covering to match your costume
- Consider goodie bags
 - Wash hands prior to preparing goodie bags
 - Give out bags at the end of the driveway or stairs for children to grab & go
- If giving out individually wrapped sweets, the resident must distribute sweets to kids; no kids' hands in bowls
- Consider placing markers in your yard so children have visual markers for the prescribed six feet
- Make sure hands are cleaned before eating any sweets

DON'Ts

- Avoid touching high-touch surfaces that can spread the virus that causes COVID-19
 - Avoid door-to-door and ringing doorbells
 - Avoid eating treats until after getting home; wash hands to reduce hand-to-mouth transmission
- Avoid crowded indoor parties and haunted houses where there may be crowds and screaming
- Stay at home if you feel unwell, have tested positive for COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19
